On the occasion, Dr. Nasir and Dr. Rameez congratulated the organizing committee for being highly efficient and commended the time management skills of the committee.

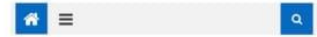
Dr. Rameez said the IET has been conducting such events and from the past year it was the fourth event that the centre has hosted so far. We will continue holding such events in future also, he said.

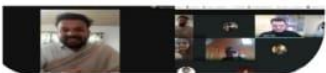
